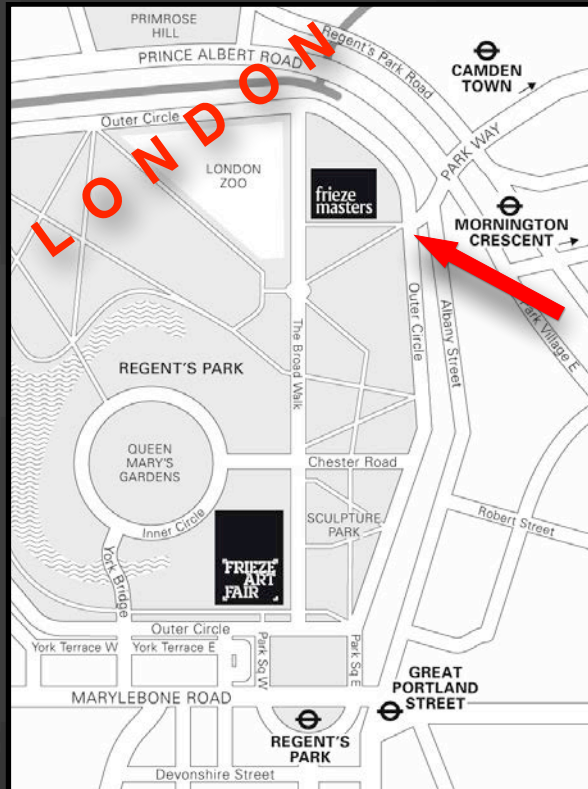

New Ireland, Bismarck Archipelago, PNG, Melanesia. *Tridacna gigas*, turtle-shell, and bush-string. 14 ø x 0.2 cm. 19/20th century. Ex-coll. Hans Nevermann circa 1933/34, Chief Curator of the Oceania Department at the Völkerkunde Museum, Berlin. Then by exchange / gift to Serge Brignoni, artist and collector, Berne. Ex private collection, France.

Inside : A very fine female figure. Punuk culture, Bering Strait, Alaska. Mineralized walrus tusk (*Odobenus rosmarus divergens*). 600 – 900 AD. 6,7 cm.
