An Eskimo female figure who appears to be wearing a mask. The finely modeled face shows the typical linear tattoos on the chin. Early Thule Culture, Alaska. Mineralized walrus tusk (*Odobenus rosmarus divergens*). 8 cm. 1200 – 1600 AD.
